

Dick Rutan American Hero "The Velvet Arm" Born July 1, 1938

Joined US Air Force 1957

Misty Fighter Pilot F-100 Super Saber Vietnam 1965 to 1968

Shot Down Over North Vietnam 1968

F-100 Nuclear Alert in England Ejected, Following Engine Failure 1969 to 1976

Commanded Maintenance Squadron Tucson, Arizona 1976 to 1977

Test Pilot for Rutan Aircraft Factory & SCALED Composites 1977 to 1980

Commanded Voyager 9-Day Flight Round-the-World, Nonstop without Refueling 1986

Spirit of EAA Friendship Flight, Round-the-World Long-EZs with Mike McIvill 1997

Attempted a Round-the-World Balloon Flight 1998

Stranded at the North Pole 2000

Retired to North Idaho 2021

Flew West May 3, 2024

CdA Advisory Board: no report

Guest Speaker: Kirk L from CdA Aviation/Maintenance gave the reasons behind the June 29th Air Event cancellation: out of respect for the Celebration of Dick Rutan event and the fact that many folks would want to attend without conflict and he felt that it was not the right timing for the Air Event. CdA A/M felt it should not host a paid event without being able to accommodate all the planned activities, and most certainly did not want to interfere with the Celebration for Dick Rutan.
